

The following motions have been received and will be presented to the membership for vote at the 2017 AGM. There is one vote per registered member. In the event of an equality of votes, the Chair shall have a second and casting vote to retain the status quo.

## Motion 1

Amendment to article 1.2 of the constitution; It will now read "The club colours shall be blue, white and navy."

## Motion 2

Amendment to article 4.12 of the constitution; It will now read "Each member shall be directed to the club constitution on the club website, on being admitted as members of the club."

## Motion 3

Amendment to article 8.2 of the constitution; It will now read "The Club Secretary shall give twenty eight days' notice in writing of the Annual General Meetings to all members and shall display this notice on the club website and social media site."

## Motion 4

Amendment to article 8.5 of the constitution to include the role of membership secretary.

## Motion 5

Amendment to article 11.2.1 of the constitution; It will now read "The Secretary shall take minutes of all Committee and General Meetings. Minutes of all meetings should be recorded and filed appropriately by the Secretary of the committee. At the subsequent meeting of the committee, the minutes must be read, corrected and passed by the Chair. The filed minutes must be handed over to the incoming Secretary at the AGM or on the resignation of the Secretary."

## Motion 6

Amendment to article 10.2 of the constitution to include the statement: "subject to limitations on serving periods, as defined by Swim Ireland constitution and rules."

## Motion 7

Removal of article 11.3.9 of the constitution (Now covered by article 10.2).
